## POLIMI OFF WORK TOURNAMENT - MIXED 6x6 VOLLEYBALL

## **RULES OF THE GAME**

## ART. 1\_ Organisation of the tournament

All players must have a valid Basic membership and a valid non-competitive sports medical certificate for the duration of the tournament.

The volleyball tournament is mixed; each team must have a mixed gender representation, with <u>at least **two**</u> <u>persons of the under-represented gender on the court;</u> this applies to all sets.

The first stage is a round-robin, in which each team meets the other teams in its pool. At the end of this first stage, the top-ranked teams from each pool will advance to the knockout stage.

The calendars, results, possible sanctions and measures and all useful information during the course of the tournament will be published and updated on the dedicated page on the <u>sports website</u>.

In the group stage, the position of each individual group on the leadership board is established according to the following scores:

- 3 points for each match won by 2 sets to 0,
- 2 points for each match won by 2 sets to 1,
- 1 point for each match lost by 1 set to 2,
- 0 points for each match lost by 0 sets to 2.

In case of tied leader board scores, the ranking will follow this order:

- a. number of matches won,
- b. set ratio (sets won/sets lost),
- c. points difference (points won points conceded),
- d. most sets won,
- e. most points scored,
- f. draw.

A team shall lose the game by forfeit if it fails to appear on the court within 15 minutes of the official starting time. Teams that do not show up will be declared losers by 0-2.

Each team can consist of a minimum of **6 players** up to a maximum of **10 players**. Players cannot be added after registration closes, except in specific cases (e.g., player injury).

Each player may participate with one team; if a player is listed on the roster of one team, they cannot be listed on the roster of another team.

The matches shall be played at the Giuriati Sports Centre on Monday and/or Thursdays (from 6 pm - <u>CLICK</u> <u>HERE</u> to see the general calendar of the activities).

The start time and dates of the tournament may be changed at the discretion of the Organising Committee. In the event of any changes, the captain(s) of the team(s) shall be notified promptly by the Organising Committee.

Once scheduled and designated, matches may not be rescheduled, except in the case of organisational problems on the part of the Organising Committee. <u>Any requests to reschedule a match shall NOT be accepted</u>.

Below are the rules of the game:

## a) DURATION

The duration of the matches is set at 2 sets of 25 points plus a possible third set of 15 points, with a 2-minute interval between sets.

### b) NET HEIGHT

The height of the playing net is set at 2.35 metres.

## c) SUBSTITUTIONS DURING PLAY

Unlimited substitutions are permitted, provided that each reserve always substitutes the same starting player.

For anything not covered above, the technical and disciplinary rules of the Italian Volleyball Federation (FIPAV) apply.

# ART. 2\_ Sanctions and additional provisions with respect to the GENERAL RULES OF TOURNAMENTS OF POLITECNICO DI MILANO

In case of bad language - swearing, profanities, etc. - against other players, will result in a first warning, followed by expulsion;

In case of bad language - swearing, profanities, etc. - towards the referee, will result in direct expulsion.

# **GAME FORMULA**

The tournament foresees a maximum number of **8 teams**. The teams will be divided into 2 groups of 4 teams each.

During the first phase, each team will play against all the other teams in its group in one-off matches. At the end of the group stage, the teams ranked **first** and **second** in each group will advance to the knockout stage.

Once the 4 teams participating in the semifinals have been fixed, the tournament will continue according to the following schedule:

1<sup>st</sup> group A vs 2<sup>nd</sup> group B 1<sup>st</sup> group B vs 2<sup>nd</sup> group A
